Dear Mr. Granger,

This letter serves as official notification that the Heath Care distinctive license plate application and design were approved by the Legislative Oversight Committee (LOC) during its April 2, 2008 meeting. **The twelve-month period in which to obtain the minimum number of "Commitments to Purchase" begins June 01, 2008 and ends May 31, 2009.**

Supporters of your organization, who wish to purchase a Heath Care distinctive license plate, may visit their local county license plate issuing official's office, complete a "Commitment to Purchase" application, and pay the \$50 additional fee. Please note that applicants will continue to use their current, valid Alabama license plate (no registration changes are made at this point in the process). The county license plate issuing official will forward the additional fee (with a copy of the application) to the State Comptroller's Office, which will monitor the funds remitted and the progress of the commitments. You may view the monthly progress of your organization's commitments on the Motor Vehicle Division's website at <http://www.revenue.alabama.gov/motorvehicle/mvforms/LOCReport.PDF>.

If sufficient commitments are not met for the distinctive license plate category within the twelve-month period, the Comptroller will disburse the funds remitted directly to your organization. There will be no further consideration for production of the new license plate category under the current application.

If the required number of commitments is received, the Comptroller will notify the Department of Revenue and disburse the funds collected as indicated on the Application for a New Distinctive License Plate Category form. The new license plates will be ordered, manufactured and delivered to the county offices. The Department of Revenue will notify county officials and the sponsoring organization of the expected availability date. Your organization will be responsible for notifying all supporters.

After the license plates are available in the county offices, applicants who purchased pre-commitments for the Heath Care distinctive license plate **must** present, to the county license plate issuing official, the **original "Commitment to Purchase"** application form. The county receipt showing prepayment of the \$50 additional fee **must** also be presented. Distinctive license plates **will not** be issued without these two documents. Please note that photocopies of the forms will not be accepted.

License Plate Notification of Application and Design

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If the applicant desires to obtain the license plate before the current plate has expired the current license plate must be returned to the county official for audit purposes. If the license plate is expired, it is not necessary to return it to the county official. Applicable issuance fees must be paid to the county official before a license plate will be issued. If the required documents are presented to the county official, the applicant will receive credit for the prepayment of the \$50 additional fee.

LEGAL NOTICE: ACT 97-633 established guidelines for the authorization of new distinctive license plate categories (tag types). This act sets a minimum number of commitments to purchase that must be received before new distinctive license plates are manufactured (250-999 for Quantity Class 1 and 1,000 or more for Quantity Class 2). Each Alabama resident desiring to register a vehicle with a new category license plate, which has been approved by the Legislative Oversight Committee (LOC), shall apply through his/her local county tag issuing official and remit, as a commitment to purchase, the \$50.00 additional fee per license plate. **The \$50.00 additional fee remitted as a commitment to purchase is NONREFUNDABLE by the state or county officials. The law provides that a license plate cannot be manufactured until the minimum number of commitments are received.**

INSTRUCTIONS / PROCEDURES FOR "COMMITMENT TO PURCHASE"

- Applicants must complete this "Commitment To Purchase" Application and submit it along with the additional fee of \$50.00 per license plate commitment to the local license plate issuing official. (Collected annually once distinctive tag is issued.) The top portion of this form MUST be completed, including vehicle information. This application is limited to four "Commitments to Purchase" license plates; applicants desiring more than four license plates must complete a separate form. If the new license plate category is restricted to organizational members only, PROOF OF MEMBERSHIP MUST BE PROVIDED. A SEPARATE APPLICATION MUST BE COMPLETED FOR EACH DISTINCTIVE LICENSE PLATE CATEGORY.
- Applicants should CONTINUE TO USE THEIR CURRENT, VALID ALABAMA LICENSE PLATE (no registration changes are made at this step in the process).
- The county issuing official will forward the additional fee to the State Comptroller's Office who will monitor the funds remitted for each new license plate category and:
 - If sufficient commitments are not met for a category within the 12 months following LOC approval, the Comptroller will disburse the funds remitted for that category to the sponsoring organization. There will be no further consideration for production of the new license plate category under the current application; or
 - If the required number of "Commitments to Purchase" are received, the Comptroller will notify the Department of Revenue and disburse the funds collected to the appropriate recipients. The new license plates will be ordered, manufactured, and delivered to the county offices. The Department of Revenue will notify county officials and the sponsoring organization of the expected availability date. The SPONSORING ORGANIZATION will be responsible for notifying the applicants.
- After the license plates are available in the county offices, applicants who prepaid must present to the county license plate issuing official: (a) an ORIGINAL COPY of the application form; (b) the COUNTY RECEIPT showing prepayment of the \$50.00 per plate additional fee; (c) their current Alabama license plate, which must be held by the county official for audit purposes (unless it is their renewal month and the current tag is expired); and (d) the issuance fee.

NOTE: There is no requirement that registrants who prepay must immediately obtain the new distinctive license plate when it is available. Registrants may elect to wait until their designated renewal month to obtain the plate and receive credit for the \$50.00 additional fee.
